- * AGES: As at 27th November 2010
- * CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: **SUNDAY 12TH SEPT 2010 ONE ENTRY FOR ALL GALAS**
- * LATE ENTRIES: Late entries will not be accepted. Entries only accepted on the day from 8's and under. New swimmers joining after closing date may still enter upto 2 weeks before each gala.
- * ENTRY FORM: Entry forms to be completed and handed in to John/Louise Sanders or at the club desk at Dudley Leisure Centre on Sunday evening by closing date. Please ask if you have a problem completing the form.
- * NUMBER OF ENTRIES: Younger swimmers are advised to enter a maximum of 3 events per gala
- * SUBMITTED TIME: Except for 25m swims, times will be required for all events. If you wish to enter an event but have no time, enter "00" on the entry form
- * REJECTED SWIMS: The club may reject any entry for the following reasons
 - a) The teachers/coaches do not feel the swimmer is able to complete the event or,
 - b) No time has been submitted from a regular club swimmer who has a time.
- * TIMES: All events except 8's, 9's and over 25's will be seeded on times.
- * AWARDS:
 - a) All 8's and under will receive a Club Championship competitors medal.
 - b) Awards will be given to all finalists in 25m and 50m events & top 3 for HDW events (i.e. 100 & 200m events)
 - c) Disqualification in a final will be placed 6th and receive a finalist medal.
 - d) Points will be awarded to the swimmers at the end of each event.
6 for 1st place, 5 for 2nd place, 4 for 3rd place, 3 for 4th place, 2 for 5th place, 1 for 6th place
No points will be awarded for disqualification.
 - e) Top boy, top girl in each age group (8yrs & under, 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13/14yrs & 15yrs & over, Junior (14yrs & under) and Senior (15yrs & over) trophies will be awarded to the swimmer with the most points at the end of the championships.
8 yr olds - total points from 4x 25 metre events
9 yr olds - total points from 4x 25 metre events and 100m IM
All other age groups - best points from 3x 50m events (Free, Back, Breast, Fly),
3x 100m events (Free, Back, Breast, Fly) 3x 200m events (Free, Back, Breast, Fly)
Best 2 IM s (100IM / 200IM / 400IM) and 400 Freestyle.
 - f) Presentations will be made at the Christmas Disco on Saturday 18th December 10 at Oldswinford Hospital School.
- * HEATS: Mixed races will take place at the discretion of the promoter i.e. if there are too few swimmers in an event.
- * SWIMMERS: All swimmers taking part in any of the events must attend the warm up and report to stewards at least one event before their swim.
- * 50M MEDLEY SKINS: The swimmers for these events will be the fastest 6 male and female swimmers from the 100m Individual Medley. A prize will be offered to the winner and the runner up in each event.
- * TIME TRIALS will be available for 9 year olds in 50m & 200m events at the discretion of the Head Coach for the purpose of entry times to Crystal Open and Worcester Counties. No medals or points will be awarded from these time trials. Entries must be submitted in advance on the entry form and indicated by letters TT. Entries for time trials will not be accepted on the day.
